



## AGILYX STATEMENT ON OREGON DEQ PROPOSED PENALTY

**Beaverton, Oregon USA – November 18, 2014**

On October 28, 2014, Agilyx Corporation received a penalty letter from the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality (“DEQ”) relative to issues observed more than a year earlier at the company’s Tigard, Oregon plant. The issues cited by DEQ in 2013, were predominantly administrative in nature. The company responded to and took proper corrective action on all of the issues raised by DEQ within ten days of initial verbal notice of the purported violations. In May 2014, Agilyx received the related Notice of Violation (“NOV”) from DEQ for these infractions. None of the issues raised by DEQ involved environmental health impacts or created risk to the public. DEQ acknowledged that the issues have been addressed. Agilyx appealed the NOV to address inaccuracies in the document that significantly inflated the penalty being sought.

Agilyx is committed to safety, health and environmental excellence. We have a responsibility to our stakeholders, including our employees, customers, shareholders, and the public, to ensure a safe and healthy work environment while striving to exceed regulatory rules and expectations.
