The Director of Operations plans, directs, organizes, integrates and provides oversight of District's Materials Recovery Facility (MRF), equipment maintenance, site & facilities maintenance, landfill operations, scales operations, Last Chance Mercantile (LCM) and Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) operations; collaborates with Engineering staff to ensure optimal efficiencies of solid waste processing operations; directs and manages the development of short and long-term goals and objectives consistent with the Strategic Plan and annual business plan and ensures their effective execution. Positions at this class level serve as a member of the District's senior management team and provide advice and counsel to the General Manager regarding strategic policy and problem solving issues relating to the assigned Departments and the District overall. A person appointed to the Director of Operations classification is an "at-will" employee.

SUMMARY OF EDUCATION, TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE:

A Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university with major course work in environmental planning and management; environmental studies; environmental, civil, safety or industrial engineering; solid waste planning or a related field is required. A master's degree in civil, safety or industrial engineering or a related field, is highly desirable.

Ten to 15 years of broad and progressively responsible work experience in recycling program operations, transfer station management, or combined and related experiences.

REQUIRED LICENSES OR CERTIFICATIONS:

Possession of or ability to obtain a certificate of Manager of Landfill Operations (MOLO) issued by the Solid Waste Association of North America (SWANA) is required or obtained within one year of hire date. Possession of valid California driver's license is required. A valid certificate of registration as a licensed Civil Engineer, Mechanical Engineer, or Geologist issued by the State Board of Registration for Civil, Geologist, and Professional Engineers is desired.
